PA Plan To Reduce Pollution Going To Chesapeake Bay Does Not Meet EPA Requirements



Matthew Ehrhart, Executive Director of Chesapeake Bay Foundation's <u>Pennsylvania office</u>, released this statement after completing a preliminary review of the Department of Environmental Protection's <u>draft Watershed Implementation</u> <u>Plan</u> designed to reduce nutrients and sediment in Pennsylvania streams going to the Chesapeake Bay.

"The EPA's Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) requirements compel all Bay states to do even more to protect

our streams, rivers, and the Chesapeake Bay from intensive nutrient pollution.
